The Arthur B. McDonald Chairs have been created to recognize and retain professors of high-calibre at Dalhousie University. A Chair carries with it a \$50k/year cash award and extends for a period of up to seven years (or retirement). The funding may be used entirely for the awardee's program of research or a portion (no greater than half) may be used as a salary stipend with the remainder being used for research support. Faculties are expected to provide partial teaching release to allow awardees increased time to focus their research efforts. The McDonald Chair is a non
